## THE WOMEN'S DEVELOPMENT CELL

The Women Development Cell of Sri Guru Gobind Singh College of Commerce organized an event - Jashn-e-Azadi on 15 February 2023. The tagline "breaking the glass ceiling" celebrates women who have won battles against the patriarchy. Four women, all masters in their fields were invited for a mega-speaker session.

## 1. The Speaker Session

The speakers were:

- Dr. Valli Arunachalam, a nuclear scientist and semiconductor technology consultant, is the scion of Murugappa Group. She has been fighting for a fair share in her family business.
- Dr. Mridula Tandon is a medical doctor, social entrepreneur, philanthropist, president, and co-founder of an NGO - SAKSHI, and the Jashn-e-Hind foundation. She has won several accolades and awards.
- Ms. Hiba Malik is Community Engagement and HR Lead at Even Cargo which is India's first all-women last-mile logistics company, started with a mission to create equal livelihood opportunities for women, coming from resource-poor backgrounds. She is a mental health advocate and passionate about women's empowerment.
- Ms. Esha Mishra is a Broadcast Journalist at CNN News 18, a voice-over artist, and a Producer of Blitz- a special speed news segment at CNN-News 18. She has been covering meaningful and powerful stories, including deprivation, victims of custodial torture, ex-prisoners, mental health, and violence against women.

The speaker session started with a Shabad performed by Vismaad, the Divinity Society of the college. Following this, the speakers were called upon the stage to discuss their journeys and impart words of wisdom to the audience. The session was a great success as the listeners, majorly comprising college students, gained useful insights.

## 2. The Inter-college competitions

The speaker session was followed by 2 inter-college competitions organized by WDC: Bid To Win and Flip Your Luck with lucrative cash prizes.
