Agenda: Formulation of policy for the implementation of research work in VII Semester for the Academic Year 2025–26

Proceedings:

The meeting of the Research Committee of the College (RCC) was convened on 9th September 2025 to deliberate on the policy for the implementation of research work in the VII Semester for the Academic Year 2025–26. The following points were discussed:

1. It was informed that 85 students have paid the fee for the fourth year across all courses.
2. DU notifications CNC-II/093/1/EC-1273/2024-25/449 dated 10/02/2025 and CN-II/093/1/EC-1276/2025/17 dated 04/08/2025 were discussed.
3. It was decided that the Entrepreneurship Track will not be floated, as two GE subjects are prerequisites for it. It is not feasible to introduce new GEs at this stage.
4. Dissertation and Academic Project Tracks will be offered to students in all departments. Students will be given the choice to select one of these tracks.
5. Each department will circulate a Google Form to students asking them their track preference and Area of Interest/Dissertation topic.
6. The Subject Research Committee (SRC) of each department will consist of the TIC and two faculty members (on a rotation basis).
7. It was suggested that since the TIC will be part of both RCC and SRC, they may not be included in any ACR. All other faculty members must be part of some ACR.
8. All faculty members in the department shall be allocated an equal number of students, wherever possible. It was advised to collect information from other colleges regarding their mechanism for student allocation. The mechanism for allocation will be finalized in the next meeting.



9. It was proposed that a Publication Cell/Committee may be formed in the next semester to publish student work in the form of a book with an ISBN number. An international publisher may also be approached for this purpose.
10. Evaluation at the end of the VII Semester will be based on the four criteria mentioned in the UGC notification. Grading will follow a binary system – *Approved / Disapproved*.
