ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2021-22

- 1. An academic calender was formed as per DU calender, giving datelines for Internal Assessment, practical exams, OBE, Departmental meetings, orientation for students, etc. All the webinars and society planner was launched too.
- 2. A combined Orientation Programme for societies was held for three days in the month of November for first year students by IQAC team online.
- 3. A faculty Development Workshop was held to train them for better use of ICT tools for online teaching.
- 4. An annual subscription to Zoom was taken in order to facilitate holding of online sessions and seminars.
- 5. A hybrid mode International webinar was organized by the Seminar Committee in February.
- 6. A database Capital Line Prowess was subscribed for annual usage in order to facilitate research and teaching learning process in the department of Commerce and Economics.
- 7. Library RFID and online resources were made available to students and faculty. The online resources were shared with students through google classrooms by faculty members as well.
- 8. As the campus reopened, covid protocol was implemented on the campus, such as checking thermal screening at the gate, mask wearing, hand sanitizer dispensers installed at many places.
- 9. The hostel seats were allocated as per requirements and first come first serve basis.
- 10. The infrastructure is continuously upgraded. The new Ampitheatre has been renovated with latest Air conditioners, sound system, and projector. The old seminar room and conference rooms have been refurnished and all ICT facilities have been incorporated.
- 11. The air conditioning of class room block is under way.
- 12. The college has signed a MOU for solar energy installation at Narela village for upgrading our energy needs by 100 KV.
- 13. The auditorium is under renovation and repair too, so that facilities for co-curricular activities can improve.
- 14. The Self Study Report for NAAC Cycle 2 was prepared by IQAC team and uploaded on the portal.
- 15. The student centric approach to Internal Assessment was applied and no marks for attendance were allocated as per DU guidelines. The total IA has been finalized after consultation with Moderation Committee and approved by students individually for the scores.
