OBJECTIVES OF THE FDP

The Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on SmartPLS and NVivo is designed to enhance the research capabilities and teaching expertise of faculty members in quantitative and qualitative analysis. The FDP will showcase how SmartPLS and NVivo complement each other in generating richer insights and refining theoretical models. The Programme aims to develop participants' SmartPLS, encompassing proficiency model in specification, estimation techniques, model assessment, and result interpretation. It will provide hands-on training in covering tasks such as data input, model specification, parameter estimation, and result interpretation. Faculty members will be introduced to NVivo software, where they will learn qualitative data management, coding, thematic analysis, and data exploration techniques. Participants will gain the tools to incorporate SmartPLS and NVivo into their teaching, fostering critical thinking skills and engaging students in hands-on data analysis. The Programme aims at empowering participants with analytical thinking, problem-solving abilities, critical reasoning, and data interpretation skills. Moreover, it focuses on developing technical proficiency, communication skills, collaboration and teamwork abilities, knowledge of research design and methodology, and fostering a commitment to lifelong learning.
