

ONLINE CYBER SECURITY SESSION

The Department of Computer Science in association with its academic society Association of Computer Enthusiasts (ACE) organized a two day session on “Cyber Security” in collaboration with ATS Learning Solutions on the app GoToMeeting.

The session was conducted by Mr. Suresh Pal, a Mumbai-based certified corporate trainer, on 10-11th April’2020. Students were made aware of the fundamental concepts underlying the construction of secure systems, from the hardware to the software to the human-computer interface. These concepts were illustrated with examples drawn from modern practice, and augmented with hands-on exercises involving relevant tools and techniques. Various ways of hacking were demonstrated and information about various types of viruses was also provided.

The online meet was joined by around 110 students. The session was open for all the undergraduate students. Students of various backgrounds, such as commerce, computer science, economics were present.

The session was quite engaging and practical. The speaker was phenomenal. All the queries of the participants were taken on public/private chat on the app. It was an enlightening experience which enhanced awareness on cyber security and helped the participants in developing a way of thinking that is security-oriented, better understanding how to think about adversaries and how to build systems that defend against them.
