Date: 11 August 2026

The Centre of Excellence (CoE) invites students to submit innovative project proposals that address real-world societal challenges through sustainable, interdisciplinary, and technology-driven solutions. The initiative is intended to foster research, innovation, entrepreneurship, and community engagement while encouraging students to develop solutions with meaningful and measurable impact.

Project Guidelines

- Each project team may comprise a maximum of five (5) students.
- Each project may be guided by up to two faculty mentors.
- Projects should include one external mentor from industry or a foreign university, subject to approval by the CoE.
- Interdisciplinary and collaborative projects are strongly encouraged.
- Projects should demonstrate innovation, measurable social impact, and potential for research, intellectual property, entrepreneurship, or community development.

Expected Research Outcomes

Every selected project team is expected to achieve the following outcomes:

Mandatory: To submit at least one research paper to a reputed national or international conference by the middle of the current academic session. In addition, the project team should achieve at least one of the following:

- Publication in a Scopus-indexed, Web of Science (WoS)-indexed, or ABDC-listed journal.
- Patent filing, wherever applicable.
- An industry white paper, technical report, or case study developed in collaboration with an industry or community partner.

Financial Support

The Centre of Excellence/College may provide financial support in the form of a grant to selected projects, subject to the innovation and societal impact of the project, quality of work, expected research outcomes, publication potential, patentability, recommendations of the review committee, and availability of funds.
