Parents Feedback Form Analysis (2015-2016)

The parent's feedback is circulated amongst parents of all the students enrolled across various courses.

The majority of the responses received pertain to parents whose wards are enrolled in the commerce courses followed by economics as the second largest share of respondents. It has been very encouraging to see that nearly four-fifth of the respondents believed that the college has played a positive role in building the personality of their ward.

The answers pertaining to detailed feedback regarding the various aspects such as Teaching & Learning, Growth Opportunities, Infrastructure, Industry- Academia Exposure and Extra-Curricular Activities also yielded positive results.

Nearly fifty of the parents perceive the college infrastructure to be 'Good' or 'Very Good'. The teaching and learning environment also received positive responses of the superlative degree.

The industry academia exposure, from the point of view of the parents, seems to be on the neutral side with nearly equal percentage considering it to be 'Outstanding', 'Very Good', 'Good' and 'Satisfactory'.

Nearly two-thirds of the parents are satisfied or content with the extra-curricular opportunities as provided by the institution. These two areas (Industry-Academia Exposure and Extra Curricular Activities) can possibly receive improvements and be improvised upon as well.

Only half of the respondents seemed keen on being a part of the Parent-Teacher Association.

Some parents requested the facility of a girl's hostel for their daughters enrolled in the institution.
