


## Parents Feedback Form Analysis (2018-2019)



Course in which your ward is enrolled




93 percent of the parents believe that the college and its conducive environment has reformed the personality of their ward.

Do you believe that the college and its environment has transformed the personality of your ward?




39 percent of the parents consider the college Infrastructure to be 'Outstanding' and nearly 42 percent consider it to be 'Very Good'. A little more than 50 percent of the responses rated the Teaching and Learning activities in the college to be 'Very Good' whereas 23 percent rated it to be 'Outstanding'. This overwhelmingly positive response essentially indicates that the college is excelling in its core activity of providing quality education to all of its students. Around 47 percent of the parents believe that the college provides with 'Very Good' Growth Opportunities for the students.

This resonates with the additional acknowledgements received as well wherein the parents have complimented the college on providing with a great platform for the overall development of their children. 

A few parents went ahead to provide suggestive measures such as making extra-curricular activities compulsory for all the students and to hold periodic meditation sessions as well.

Please rate the following areas of the College as per your opinion


