

Hon'ble Justice G.S. Sistani Judge, Delhi High Court

Justice G.S Sistani was born on March 11th, 1958. He studied in Frank Anthony Public School, New Delhi, till 1976 and Graduated from Hindu College, Delhi University in 1979 and thereafter obtained L.L.B. degree in 1982. He was enrolled as an Advocate with the Bar Council of Delhi in 1982. He commenced his career with Kaura & Company Advocates and thereafter joined his father S. N. S. Sistani who was a reputed Senior Advocate of this Court. He practiced in Delhi High Court mainly on Commercial, Civil, Writ, Original and Companies Jurisdiction of the High Court of Delhi and the Supreme Court of India. He also appeared before the MRTP Commission, Debt Recovery Tribunal and Arbitrators. Apart from other the nature of litigation, he has handled cases relating to Constitutional, Banking, Finance and Excise, MRTP, Real Estate, Administration, Cooperate, Commercial Service etc.

He remained Advocate of Delhi Government during which he had handled all kinds of cases on their behalf including cases relating to Directorate of Education, Excise, and Service Matters etc. as well as he remained Advocate for the Delhi Development Authority. He has been a standing Counsel for Punjab & Sind Bank as well as appeared for several other Private and Nationalized Banks, Public Sector Undertakings and other Multinational Companies.

He has been appointed as an Amicus Curiae in various cases by the High Court. He has appeared in cases entrusted by the Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee. A keen sportsman, he had been a Head Boy of his school and associated with social organizations and a committee member of an aided school. He is appointed as Additional Judge of the High Court of Delhi with effect from May 29, 2006 and was confirmed w.e.f 29.8.07.

Innovations Towards A Sustainable World & Impact Of The Air Quality Crisis – A Comparative Analysis Of Delhi, Beijing, London & Los Angeles

This project was awarded 'Certificate of Appreciation for being selected for the Research Display' in the 93rd convocation ceremony in November 2016 from amongst the 314 Innovation projects awarded to 58 colleges of University of Delhi. The project was also awarded with the prestigious 'Most Significant Societal Impact Award' by University of Delhi during the research display at the convocation ceremony on November 19th, 2016.

Under the project, a survey of pulmonary function capacity test was conducted on 634 school students selected on the basis of Socio-Economic status, aged between 9-14 years

### **INNOVATION PROJECT SGGSCC-302**

Empowering Differently-abled Students through e-Learning at Higher Educational level

from 14 Delhi Schools, covering all zones of Delhi to find the effects of air quality on Lung functioning capacity of children of this age group. The project also aimed at measuring the significant influence of environment sensitive determinants on air quality and economic growth of the developed and developing countries: India, China, United Kingdom and United States. The investigators also developed a Clean Air Hub device that can sense immediate surroundings and calculate the air quality index of environment. The device works with a mobile application and can tell the concentration of individual gases present in the air.



The project was successfully completed and was awarded the 'Best poster award' in a competition held at University of Delhi.

Food Insecurity Issues in Children and Women in North India with special reference to the National Food Security Act, 2013

The project was awarded with the 'Certificate of Appreciation for Research Display' at the Convocation Ceremony on November 19th, 2016.

Two-fold objective of the research was to investigate food insecurity at the individual level particularly amongst the marginal subgroups including women and children with special reference to food security policies and NFSA guaranteeing entitlements. The broad objectives were to collect evidences of gender-specific malnutrition levels and household-based food insecurity confronting women in North India, Delhi, Rajasthan, Uttrakhand etc. to suggest promotive and preventive healthcare amongst women. Secondly, Food for Education Programme or the Mid-day Meals Scheme, a food intervention programme in the schools is a conditional programme devised for providing supplementary nutrition that is linked to enrollment in schools. of social problems. The major idea is to route these funds towards setting up of Social Business that is the key to address the concerns in a sustainable manner.



The research highlighted the role of the government in allocation and accessibility of one square meal provided by the MDMs- aided school and its influence on food insecurity issues among school's children.

Field research was conducted in the target areas in Northern Indian states viz., Delhi, Rajasthan, Uttrakhand etc. to analyze the food security concerns. Questionnaires were administered in the specified zonal areas to the beneficiaries availing midday meals. Based on field survey, a few suggestions were emerged, those if implemented can bring innovations in the lackluster field of social welfare schemes of food nutrition.

In his address, Dr. SubramanianSwamy spoke about the important issues where India still needs to work upon in order to enhance its growth story. He urged on the need for


effective implementation of the economic reforms so as to bring desired results.


reading Declamation




Performance by Gurnazar and the band on the final day of the fest thrilled the audience.

#### **New Course Committee Report**

In this age of competition, it is endeavor of every student to differentiate themselves from the crowd and be noticed by the potential employers. Recognizing this aspiration at Sri Guru Gobind Singh College of Commerce, we collaborated to bring the following four industry-relevant Add-on courses; (1) Integrated Programme on Currency, Commodities and Derivatives (IPCCD), (2) Financial Modeling (FM), (3) Sales, Marketing and Life Proficiencies, (4) Student Entrepreneurship' programme (STEP). The first two programmes were in joint collaboration with Bombay Stock Institute Limited (BIL), and the next two courses were in partnership with Global Career Smart (GCS) and Indian School of Entrepreneurship and Enterprise Development (ISEED) respectively.
