B.Com (Hons.)



B.Com (Hons.) program of the University of Delhi is designed to enable and empower students to acquire knowledge, skills and abilities to analyse and synthesize the contemporary realities pertaining to the business. The course provides for maintaining and sustaining existing business in the face of the winds of change and competition and a desperately needed perspective of sustainable growth. The program aims to instill conceptual understanding to equip students to deal with today’s business realities and prepare them to drive and face challenge of tomorrow. It also exposes the students to the world of technology and digitization in the relevant field as envisaged by scholars and policymakers. As mandated by the Government of India, this course is designed to help cultivate an entrepreneurial mindset and skills.

Total Seats – 200, General – 100, Reserved (Sikh Minority) – 100

Program Specific Eligibility

Candidates must appear in CUET in any of the following subject combinations:

Combination I: Any one Language from List A + Mathematics / Applied Mathematics + Any two subjects from List B.

OR

Combination II: Any one Language from List A + Accountancy / Book Keeping + Any two subjects from List B.

Merit will be based on the best CUET scores obtained from any of the above-mentioned combinations of subjects.

Program Specific Eligibility

Candidates must appear in CUET in any of the following subject combinations:

Combination I: Any one Language from List A + Any three subjects from List B.

OR

Combination II: Any one Language from List A + Any one subject from List B + General Aptitude Test.

Merit will be based on the best CUET scores obtained from any of the above-mentioned combinations of subjects.

Note: As the weightage of the CUET Sections is not the same, appropriate proration will be done.

B.A. (Hons.) Economics

The B.A. (Hons.) Economics curriculum offers a rigorous basis for much of the advanced thinking in the Economics discipline. It provides the student with a logical paradigm for conceptualising and interpreting the behaviour and interactions of households, firms, and government institutions. The curriculum allows students to choose elective courses from a set of courses with contemporary relevance, thereby offering students the flexibility to prepare for careers in academia, law, management, journalism, government, and many other fields. The programme is consistent with global standards in the Economics discipline. It offers training comparable to that of an undergraduate student at the world’s best universities.

B.Sc. (Hons.) Computer Science

The B.Sc. (Hons.) Computer Science curriculum offers to develop theoretical foundations in computer science to build computational thinking, analytical, and problem-solving skills. The program prepares the students for higher studies in Computer Science and its applications. The course aims to produce skilled graduates with a creative mindset who can recognize a computational problem either in IT industry or society and develop effective solutions. In addition, the students develop expertise in programming skills using contemporary programming languages used by the software industry. It covers core computer science topics like computer systems architecture, data structures, computer networks, operating systems, computer graphics, algorithms, software engineering, database management, theory of computation, artificial intelligence, and information security.

B.A. (Hons.) Business Economics



The B.A. (Hons.) Business Economics program is a perfect blend of practical, analytical and theoretical tools to imbibe proficient capabilities in students to analyse data and information for sound policy formulation and decision making. Business Economics is essentially an application-based inter-disciplinary approach to tackling business problems. The academic orientation of the course has been designed to create a strong orientation towards the seamless applicability of economics and related tools in the various functions of a business enterprise. The course equips students with tools and principles relating to subjects such as Statistics, Finance, Marketing, Economics, Econometrics with relevant software to keep abreast with the changing economic scenario and globalisation of business.

Total Seats - 40, General - 20, Reserved (Sikh Minority) - 20

Program Specific Eligibility

Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:

Any one Language from List A + Mathematics / Applied Mathematics + General Aptitude Test.

Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

*Fee Rs 125/- only chargeable for Undergraduate PwD students.



Bachelor of Manage- ment Studies (BMS)

Bachelor of Management Studies or BMS is an undergraduate program for management studies. The course allows students to obtain the knowledge and skills needed to assume management positions in a wide range of organizations. The management Studies program provides students with a solid foundation in the field of management and strategy designing. The electives allow students to develop deeper knowledge in specific areas of interest - finance, marketing, human resource management and management of the global business. In addition to the business management course, it will equip students to understand how organizations work, how they are managed and sensitize students towards national and international environments. Students centred learning focuses on skills and practices that enable lifelong learning and independent problem-solving.

Program Specific Eligibility

Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:

Any one Language from List A + Mathematics / Applied Mathematics + General Aptitude Test.

Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

B.A. (Hons.) Punjabi

This program is designed to inculcate and equip the students with threemajor components: Punjabi language, literature, and culture since all these are impregnated in our secular heritage. The student get the opportunity to understand the functional aspect of the language through spoken language symposiums and interpretation sessions.

Candidates must appear in CUET in any of the following subject combinations: Combination I: Punjabi from List A + Any three subjects from List B. OR Combination II: Punjabi and one Language from List A + Any two subjects from List B. OR Combination III: Any one Language from List A + Any three subjects from List B. OR Combination IV: Any two Languages from List A + Any two subjects from List B. Merit will be based on the best CUET score obtained from any of the above-mentioned combinations of subjects. Candidates who opted for Combination III & IV for admission will be considered only if seats remain vacant after considering all the candidates who opted for Combination I & II.

Only the Papers mentioned in List B will be considered as “Subjects” for Program-Specific Eligibility. The marks obtained by the candidate in CUET 2025 will be considered for computing the total marks according to the Program-Specific combinations of subjects for deciding merit and granting admissions in the undergraduate programs. Merit will be based only on the ‘combination of subjects in which a candidate has appeared in CUET 2025’ as mentioned in the respective Program-Specific Eligibility.



Post-Graduate Courses

Post-Graduate Diploma in International Marketing (PGDIM)

Ours is the first college under Delhi University to run the PGDIM course. The programme structure, teaching methodology and industry interaction with focus on behavioural skills and global orientation have been the key features of this course. The emphasis is on enhancing the understanding of the prevailing business environment for effective decision making. Besides lectures, an extensive use of case studies, management games and simulation exercises enable the students to acquire necessary skills expected of them.

The one year, full time, Post Graduate Diploma Programme viz., Diploma in Business Journalism and Corporate Communication, is an innovative course which aims to impart the core contents of the Public Relations (PR), Advertising, Corporate Communication, Print and Electronic Media to the students. Our consistent endeavour is to provide quality education and practical training to the young aspirants with a view to channelise their youthful energy leading them towards excellent communication skills not only in the field of news, cyber journalism, mass media but also in public relations and image building in the corporate sector.

M. Com. is a prestigious post graduate course of Delhi University which aims to enhance academic and research level in our educational institutions on one hand and prepare aspiring entrepreneurs to handle their businesses on the other. This course is run by Department of Commerce, Faculty of Commerce and Business, Delhi University with the support of few affiliated colleges. In this regard our college also provides the support of the tutorial base, library and infrastructure facilities etc. for students enrolled here. Admission to this course is based on Centralised Admission Test conducted by Department of Commerce. Students have to register themselves at Arts Faculty and indicate their choice of college which is allocated by the Department strictly on the basis of merit.

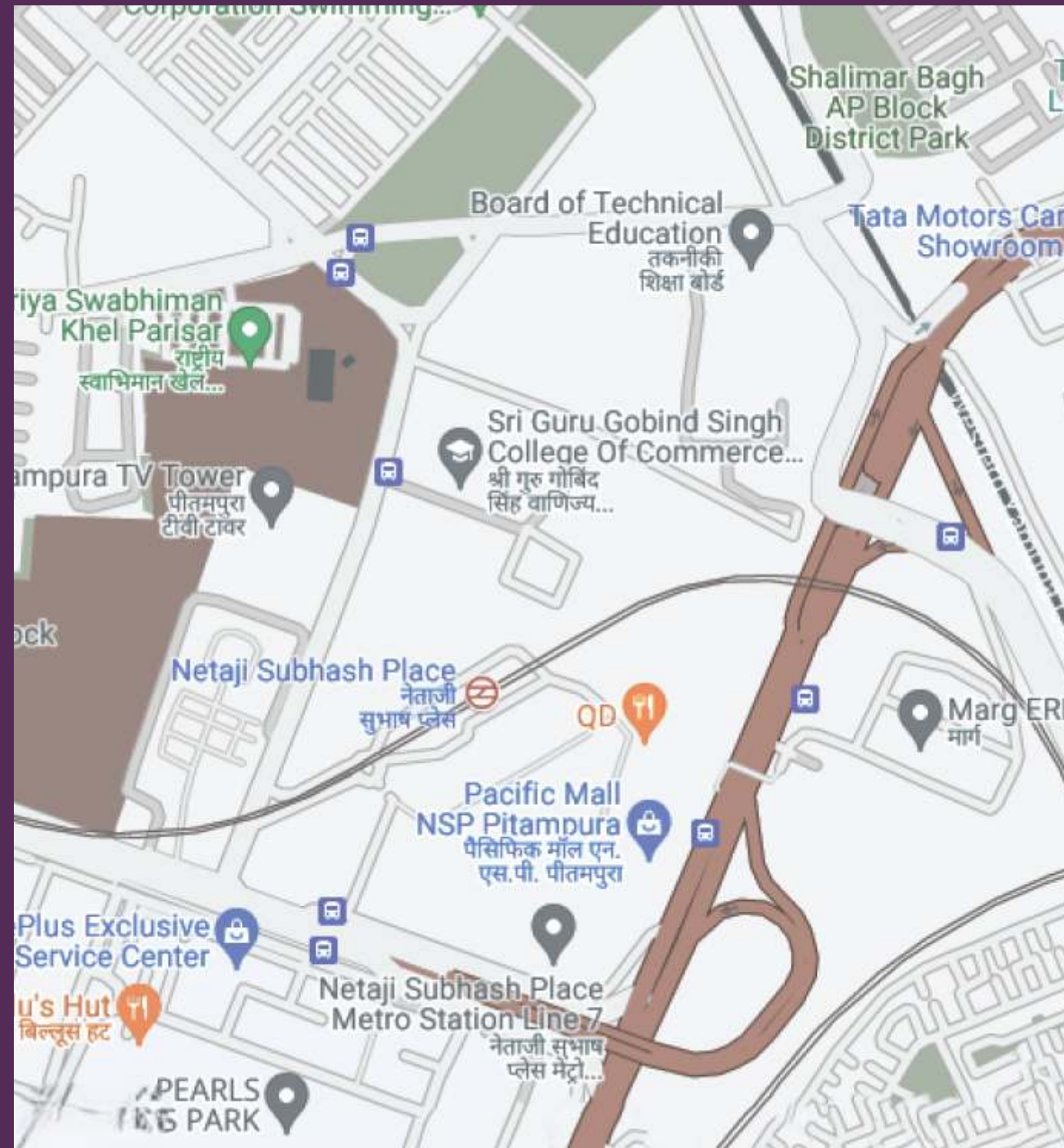
