REPORT ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY WORKSHOP

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sri Guru Gobind Singh College of Commerce successfully organized a three-day **Research Methodology Workshop from 22nd to 24th April**. The objective of the workshop was to provide an overview of the research curriculum for the 4th year under NEP-UGCF, and to spread awareness about DULS e-resources and the DU e-library platform.

The event commenced on **22nd April** with an introductory address by **Principal Dr. Jatinder Bir Singh**, setting the tone for the workshop. This was followed by insightful sessions by **Dr. Rachna Sethi, Dr. Aradhna Nanda, and Dr. Ritu Bansal**. They provided valuable insights into the structure of the research curriculum and the Research Methodology paper for the final year students.

On **23rd April**, in collaboration with the Library Committee, the workshop also celebrated World Book and Copyright Day. **Dr. Sunanda Bharti**, Professor at the Faculty of Law, University of Delhi, delivered an insightful talk on **“Copyright, Not Copy Paste,”** emphasizing the significance of intellectual property rights and academic integrity. On **24th April**, the final day, **Ms. Bhawna Vashishtha**, a library and research expert with 28 years of experience, conducted a highly informative session. She provided a detailed and practical guide on how to access and utilize the resources available through the Delhi University Library System (DULS) and the **DU E-Library Platform**. Her session offered a very insightful experience to the students, making them better equipped to explore and use academic resources effectively.
