Project Seher addresses the dual challenges of food waste and malnutrition by transforming surplus and discarded food into value-added and eco-friendly products.

Through decentralized innovation and community-led action, the project builds a circular economy model that uplifts vulnerable communities while promoting environmental sustainability and local self-help groups strengthen its impact by enabling the production of FSSAI approved nutraceutical superfood kits, sustainable biofuels, and chemical-free cleaning agents.

By creating livelihoods and ensuring inclusive development, this project supports 11 out of the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), conducting 48 food distribution drive, impacting 14926 lives, demonstrating that waste, when reimagined, can nourish lives, fuel economies, and sustain communities.

Project Zariva tackles plastic pollution by building a structured system for collection and recycling, turning discarded plastic into accessibility aids and sustainable products that give independence, mobility, and dignity to the visually impaired.

It addresses two key issues: the environmental damage caused by unrecycled plastic and the lack of affordable, dignified tools for the visually impaired. By creating smart canes, recycled sunglasses, and other solutions, Zariya reduces waste and carbon emissions while also supporting waste workers with dignified livelihoods.

This project supports 11 out of the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), impacting 930 lives. Zariya stands as a model of inclusive and sustainable development serving people, planet and our shared prosperity.
