

## **.SGGSCC-Centre of Excellence Report for the Academic Session: 2022-23**

To encourage young researchers and academicians, the academic session 2022-23 began with a webinar on *Systematic Literature Review*. Systematic Literature Reviews or SLRs are a way of synthesising all published evidence on a topic and appraising the quality of this evidence. As a research methodology, it is used to examine data and findings of other authors relative to a specified research question. The webinar was jointly conducted by Prof. Meena Mathur, Professor at FMS, MLS University, Udaipur, Rajasthan and Dr. Montu Bose, Assistant Professor, Department of Policy and Management Studies, TERI School of Advanced Studies.



A call for project proposals to be undertaken jointly by the College faculty and students from the College, under the aegis of COE, was announced in June 2022 and presentations for the proposals was organised on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2022. Prof. (Retired) Suresh Aggarwal, Department of Business Economics, University of Delhi and Prof. Pankaj Gupta, Centre for Management Studies, Jamia Millia Islamia University, along with our Principal Dr. Jatinder Bir Singh were members of the Appraisal Committee. Eight project proposals were accepted and a subsequent review of the progress of the accepted projects was organised on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2023. Prof. (Retired) Suresh Aggarwal and Prof. Madan from the Department of Commerce, University of Delhi assessed all the projects via interactions/presentations by the investigators and found the progress of all the projects to be satisfactory.



Two Workshops on Qualitative Research Methods were organised on 16<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2023 respectively in collaboration with the IQAC unit of the College. Prof. Hemandra Dangi, from Department of Commerce, University of Delhi was the resource person for both the sessions. He helped acquaint the faculty with the software NVIVO in the first session and extensively discussed Bibliometric Analysis in the latter session. 25 faculty members attended the sessions.

The Centre in collaboration with and Department of Business Economics and Management Studies organised a three-session workshop, titled **“Basic Research Workshop - A Practical Approach using SPSS,”** on the 21st, 24th and 27th of February 2023. Dr Meenu Chopra, Assistant Professor, Department of Business Economics and Management Studies, the resource person for the workshop, introduced the students to the nuances of the research process. The enriching sessions focused on imparting the basic skills in research techniques and statistical tests to 30 students from various courses.



To prepare students of Economics (Hons) to undertake research oriented projects, COE conducted two hands-on training sessions on the statistical package, SPSS and the econometric package Gretl on 4th and 5th March 2023 respectively. The sessions were conducted by Dr. Ankita Aggarwal, Assistant Professor, Department of Business Economics and Management Studies and Dr. Deepika Goel, Associate Professor, Department of Economics, Aryabhata College, University of Delhi. The workshop was attended by 50 participants and both the sessions ended with an absorbing interaction with speakers.
