

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) REPORT 2019-20

With a view to provide an insight to the first year students about co-curricular activities, a 'Common **Orientation Session**' was organized by the IQAC of the College in the month of July. It was a three day event wherein all the College societies introduced the students to their respective goals and what they as an institution have to offer to the students.

The IQAC organised a six-day **Faculty Development Workshop**, titled "Innovation and Entrepreneurship" from 14th to 19th January 2019. This was in association with Sydney Business School, University of Wollongong, Australia. Professor Grace McCarthy Dean, Sydney Business School, University of Wollongong, Australia was the main resource person of the workshop.

On 30th August 2019, the Cell organised a **career counselling** session for the students of Sarvodaya Vidyalaya, Pitampura, as an extension of IQAC activities for social cause.

The IQAC successfully organized two **workshops** for the non-teaching staff of the college on August 30, 2019 and Sep. 6, 2019. The workshops were conducted keeping in the mind the growing digitization in every field and the thus, the need for every individual to stay abreast with the usage of computers. Both the sessions were conducted by Ms. Neha Aggarwal and Ms. Mussart Ahmed from the Department of Computer Science.

It organized a **National Symposium** on 'Accreditation and Ranking: A Pathway to Excellence,' in association with the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), on 26th September, 2019. The event witnessed participation of many dignitaries, faculty members from various central and private universities, industry professionals and students. Some of the guests include Prof. C. Raj Kumar, Vice Chancellor, O.P. Jindal Global University, keynote speaker, Prof. Kavita Sharma, President, South Asian University, and Prof. Alok Pandey, Director IMS, Ghaziabad.

Prof. Sanjay Dhamija presented a technical seminar on, "How to Write a Case Study" for faculty on September, 16, 2019. On October 21, the cell with ACE - The Association of Computer Enthusiasts, organised a **seminar** in collaboration with Microsoft about their certifications exam for benefit of students.

The IQAC and BSE-SGGSCC Centre of Excellence (COE), collectively organized a **Faculty Development Workshop** on "Safety in Cyber Space", on 3rd January, 2020. The workshop was attended by both teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. The resource persons were Advocate Neeraj Arora and Dr. Sunaina Kanojia, OSD, Institute of Cyber Security and Law, University of Delhi.

The session on "Effective Stress Management in Modern Times" was organised in association with BSE-SGGSCC Centre of Excellence on 15th Jan 2020, with Dr. Ishita Bhardwaj, Assistant Professor, Department of Psychology, as the resource person.

The new college website has been launched with the joint efforts of website committee and IQAC. The information centre has been created for collection and dissemination of the information to appropriate contacts. The internal assessment and issue of clearance and admit cards have been made online through mobile app smart prof. The community initiatives have been enhanced by applying to "Unnat Bharat" scheme of Government of India where the college will adopt five villages.
